## Challenging Children Being Brought to the Office for Discipline

There has been debate in the past as to whether or not it is productive to bring "challenging" children to the office when you feel you need additional help. The answer is no. It is actually counter productive when bringing a child to the office because it always under-minds your authority. It is also difficult to discipline a child without seeing them in action in the environment which the "offense" occurred. Like we have done in the past, you are requested to use the black call button in your room to call someone from the office to come down to observe. As a third party, the office can review the big picture and sometimes come up with something you might not have thought about because the child or challenge has created frustration. We will sometimes just need to come into the room, sit and observe the situation. We will help you problem solve and let you continue to be the authority as we come along side you and the child. We can help facilitate any ideas that we all come up with. In the end, you want them to respect you as their authority and not have to use the office as a threat.

So the rule is, do not bring children to the office when they are challenging your patience. You are to push the black call button and request the office to come help. <sup>5</sup> Love the LORD vour God with all your heart and with all your soul and with your all strength. 6 These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children.
